PRECAUTIONS

1. Ensure that the electricity supply is adequate for the unit to be installed.
2. Remove all the packaging from the appliance. Remove the protective film covering the stainless steel panels.
3. When siting the unit, ensure that there is free airflow around and behind it. Ensure the appliance is level. Ensure that there is a gap of at least 25mm between connecting item (including walls).
4. Walls, partitions, kitchen furniture etc. in close proximity to the appliance must be of fireproof construction.

INSTALLATION OF THE HOT CUPBOARD

Before connecting to the electricity supply: -

1. Using a little mild detergent, wipe all the surfaces. **Do not use abrasives.** Take care not to touch the element.
2. Wipe away any detergent residue with a clean damp cloth.
3. Make sure the appliance is dry before use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure the appliance is level and correctly sited.
2. If fitted with casters, ensure that the brake has been correctly applied to the front casters
3. Ensure the door closes correctly.
4. Ensure the shelves are correctly located on the shelf supports.
5. Switch on the power supply. The red neon will indicate that the power is "ON".

6. Turn the control knob clockwise to the desired setting. The amber neon will indicate that power is going through to the element.
7. Turn OFF by rotating the knob anti-clockwise to position "0".
8. When not in use, turn OFF at the power supply.

MOBILE UNITS ONLY

When the hot cupboard has been loaded with food, ensure that the doors are secured with the latch before moving it.

1. With the latch handle raised and horizontal, place the hook over the keep plate.
2. Rotate the handle clockwise to the vertical position to tighten the hook onto the keep plate.
3. Lay the handle down flat to secure.
4. To open the door, lift the handle and rotate 90° anticlockwise until the handle is horizontal.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Disconnect from the mains electricity supply.
2. Allow to cool.
3. Clean the body of the appliance with a damp cloth and detergent. **Do not use abrasives.**
4. To remove the shelves, lift up one end to clear the shelf supports and hold at an angle to clear the doors.
5. To refit the shelves, reverse section 4.
